3. The degree of Doctor of Divinity, or its equivalent.

Additional criteria include:

1. Applicant must be a legal resident of the Louisville area
2. No scholarship will be awarded to any person who has or will have attained the age of 30 years prior to the beginning of his/her first year of study towards the degree
3. Recipient will be under a moral obligation to assist disadvantaged and deprived persons in his/her community by means of the exercise of the skills and talents acquired by the recipient through his/her scholarship
4. No scholarship shall be awarded to any applicant who has obtained any other scholarship for the same degree program

If you know anyone who is interested in applying for this scholarship, please give him/her the attached application. The application deadline is April 30th of each year. The final selection will be based on a committee's decision. The committee is comprised of individuals who have a strong desire to see that Ms. Kaufman's intentions are strictly adhered to.
